Tuition Includes:

- Fully accredited, US university-level courses (6 credits for Summer Term).
- Basic classroom material fees for all studio classes.
- Art History museum entrances, guided overnight trip to Venice, affiliated ground transportation, entrance to Venice Biennale.

Activity Fee Includes:

- A full orientation program.
- Welcome Breakfast.
- Organization of optional extra- curricular social and cultural events.
- A day in Chianti countryside including ground transportation and Tuscany picnic.

Student Services Fee Includes:

- Pre-departure advising by Florence School of Fine Arts staff in Italy.
- 5-day per week access to Florence School of Fine Arts.
- 24-hour emergency phone service and trained health and security staff on campus at all times when Florence School of Fine Arts is open.
- Assistance with medical and other personal needs.
- Assistance with health insurance and police registration.
- Internet access in educational facilities (WiFi).

Housing Fee Includes:

- Fully furnished and equipped apartments with kitchens, living rooms, and double or single bedrooms
 within walking distance to Florence School of Fine Arts in the historic center of Florence. (All apart
 ments are registered in accordance with Italian law.) Florence School of Fine Arts apartments also
 meet strict health and safety standards and are covered by fire and third-party liability insurance.)
 A reasonable use of utilities is also included.
- Full-time housing staff available to assist students with housing emergencies and repairs
- Internet access (WiFi)
- Washing machine
